3. Paper should be in double column IEEE format (.doc).
4. Paper Title, Author name(s), address, and email-ID must be indicated clearly in the manuscript.
5. Full Paper should be send through mail on or before 15<sup>th</sup> September 2016.
6. Two hard copies and one soft copy should be available at the time of event.

## Quiz

1. All teams have to undergo a prelims round, of which the top four teams will be selected for the finals.
2. A team should comprise of 2 members.
3. In all eventualities the decision of the Judges will be final.

## Short Film

1. The film must be of Social Relevance.
2. Film duration should not exceed 5 minutes.
3. Maximum of 2 members per team.
4. The video clip should be either in Tamil or English.
5. The film should reach us on or before 21<sup>st</sup> September by post or in person.
6. Any film show casting vulgarity or harmful to a person will be immediately rejected.

## Debugging

1. Single phase event.
2. Maximum of two members per team.
3. C / C++ program will be given with some bugs.
4. Participants have to rectify the bug within the stipulated time.

## General Guidelines

1. Registration starts at 09.00 A. M. in the morning.
2. All Participants should bring their college Identity Card.
3. Team registration will be based on individual departments.
4. Maximum number of participants for a team is limited to 8.
